Backpacks for Success • Going back to school isn't cool if you don't have a backpack. Thousands of OC families are struggling to make ends meet, and sometimes purchasing backpacks and school supplies isn't feasible. That's why during May 1st - June 30th we officially launch our Backpacks for Success Drive to help raise funds and supplies to help youth who will head back to school in the fall. You can host a fundraising drive and help collect \$20 per backpack or \$10 per school supply kit or donate fully stocked backpacks including essential supplies from our Needs List. Needs List is available in April on our web site: capoc.org/backpacks. Last year with Orange County's help, we collected 2,090 backpacks for youth.

Adopt-a-Family • In October, we launch our annual Adopt-a-Family program. CAP OC selects families that are facing incredible hardship that could truly use some support during the holiday season. Family profiles are posted on our website in the Fall and includes wish lists for each family member with ages, sizes and needed items. Marina was able to receive 6 backpacks for her 6 school-aged children at one of our first backpack distributions this year at Southwest Community Center. Because they are a large family, they are always looking for ways to stretch their budget to provide for the family. While she usually struggles during this time of year with Back-to-School, she was relieved she no longer had to stress about the basics and stated how genuinely grateful she felt, "It may seem like a little bit of help, but to me it's a tremendous help to have one less thing to worry about for my children".

Cryptocurrency Donations • We're excited to share CAP OC is creating more impact through innovation. In order to increase our mission's reach, we're accepting over 50 different cryptocurrencies. Visit **capoc.org/donate-crypto** to learn which types and to donate. Did you know that donating crypto is a non-taxable event, meaning you do not owe capital gains tax on the appreciated amount and can deduct the donation from your taxes. This makes Bitcoin, Ethereum, and other crypto donations one of the most tax-efficient ways to support our cause.

Combines the fun of a design-build competition with an ingenious way to help feed hungry people. Local prominent architectural, engineering, planning, and design firms create phenomenal structures built entirely out of canned food.
The structures go on view to the public at South Coast Plaza (in conjunction with the Festival of Children), John Wayne Airport, and ARTIC throughout the month of September.

is for Day of Service • Every Martin Luther King Jr Day, our OC Food Bank hosts a volunteer day where community members can make their "day off" a "day on" with a Day of Service. Join us to celebrate the life and legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. through meaningful service! This is a high-energy project where volunteer "Packing Partners" will assemble and pack food boxes, working side-by-side (socially distanced) as a sign of unity and equality. Food Boxes will be delivered to seniors in need throughout the OC community. We hope to see you in 2025!

Diaper Bank • Today, more families are struggling than ever before and basic needs like diapers are one of those expenses that very lowincome families have difficulty obtaining. Thanks to the launch of our Diaper Bank in 2020, we are able to provide a monthly supply of free diapers to families in need. In 2021, we distributed 25 million diapers to income-qualified families in Orange County. Support our Diaper Bank with a donation at capoc.org/donate

is for Family Resource Centers • CAP OC operates two family resource centers located in some of the most vulnerable areas of Orange County. Anaheim Independencia and El Modena Family Resource Centers provide supportive services for 1,000 low-income families annually. Both centers offer senior and youth programs, family strengthening and development, nutrition services, financial empowerment and employment assistance, and food, utility, tax, and rent/mortgage assistance. You can donate items such as clothes, books, and other items. Volunteer to support activities such as tutoring and holiday activities.

Food Drives • The OC Food Bank, a program of Community Action Partnership of Orange County, provides food and resources for more than 200 hunger-fighting partners throughout Orange County. Food Drives help provide supplemental items that we do not receive from product donations through distributors and grocery chains. Non-perishable items such as canned meats, beans, and cereals are in high-need. You and your company or a group of friends can request a food barrel and host a drive. Future is Working • Join us for an annual one-day Giving Day to help build the workforce in Orange County! In 2021, CAP OC launched a pilot workforce development program to help young adults learn the skills needed to enter the workforce. From training to personal development, CAP OC staff help young adults ages 18-24 discover who they are as individuals, learn skills and get into the workforce. Every March, in partnership with Orange County Community Foundation and 14 other nonprofits, we will raise support for our youth workforce development program. You can get involved at capoc.org





Giving Farm • Did you know right here in Orange
County we have a fully functioning 8-acre farm that
is located at Westminster High School? The farm
produces roughly 200,000 pounds of vegetables
and fruit that are then donated to the OC Food Bank
that helps feed local vulnerable families. We are always

a.m. to 12 p.m. to help prep land, plant, harvest and





Weatherization • Did you know that low-income households spend an average of 7.2% of their income on utility bills? That's more than 3x the 2.3% that is spent by higher-income households for electricity, heating & cooling. Oftentimes, due to high housing costs in Orange County, low-income residents find themselves living in older, less efficient buildings, leading to higher energy costs. The good news is CAP OC offers Weatherization services at no-cost to income qualified participants. Weatherization (or WX) is the process of protecting and modifying a home to reduce energy consumption and optimize energy efficiency. Examples of WX include replacing drafty doors or windows and insulating attics. Check out our Energy Blog at capoc.org to learn more great examples of the work we do.

Whole Family Approach • In 2020, we began to look at our programs and realign them to include a family-led strategy. The Whole Family Approach provides adults and children with the tools they need to set goals, create plans and to achieve those goals together. This approach has been proven effective in improving the family's economic and social wellbeing, carrying with it the potential to break the cycle of intergenerational poverty. CAP OC works with grandparents, parents and children to provide each with the knowledge and skills to work together achieve long-term change and stability—together. The Whole Family Approach recently began a "Success Coaches Program," in which our staff walks side by side with families.
